- 1. The Assessment Structure and Examination pattern Non-Semester Only
- 2. All Saturdays are working days from class I onwards except 2nd Saturday. 1st Saturday is a half working day up to 12.30 P.M.
- 3. Parents are requested to avoid taking their children Half day. Half Day Permission will not be given. During examination leave is not permitted. Parents must pick up their wards or arrange to pick up their wards as soon as the school closing bell is given.
- 4. Hair Cut, Uniform, Shoes, Socks, Belt, Nails will be checked every Monday. Please send the students with proper uniform neatly washed and pressed.
- 5. From VI std, all girl students should wear SALWAR KAMEEZ from the reopening day in JUNE and boys with full pant and shirt. Boys should avoid low hip pants/pencil pants.
- 6. Students must not absent themselves for Test/Exams.No Re-exam will be conducted.
- 7. Parents can drop Feedback/Suggestions in Suggestion Box. Parents can meet the teachers at all working days between 4.00 and 4.15 P.M.
- 8. 23rd April 2024 is the last working day from classes Pre.K.G to IX.
- 9. School Reopening Date: (June)

- 10. Parents are requested to respond immediately when there is a call from the school. Only parent mobile number is allowed.
- 11. **Only 8 days leave is permitted per year.** Late coming must be avoided. Parents please pay attention in sending your ward on time to school, otherwise they will be sent home.
- 12. Students must wear White uniform with white canvas shoes on all Mondays.
- On Saturdays, House Dress to be worn from classes I to V and House T.Shirt with white trousers/pant (boys) and SalwarKameez with House Coat (girls) from VI to XII. (refer school diary)
